Prof. Mazal is one of the leading Teachers in Austrian Labor Law and Social Security Law, Deputy Head of the Department of Labor Law and Social Security Law of the University of Vienna and Director of the Institute for Family Studies at the University of Vienna.

He is Member of the Faculty of Law of the University of Vienna, which is one of the leading European Law Faculties. The University of Vienna was founded in 1356 and is the oldest University of in German language and culture.

Prof. Mazal published numerous articles and books in Austria and Germany, is co-editor of the Austrian Legal Journal “ecolex” since its foundation in 1989, was editor of the Austrian Journal “Recht der Medizin” (“Law in Medicine”) from the foundation in 1994 to 2008. He is responsible for a years-long cooperation between the Law Faculty with the Law Faculty of Kyoto State University and is actually responsible for the Cooperation with CUPL and IUBE, too.
